Dr. Sauvé graduated from the Faculté de médecine vétérinaire of the University of Montreal in 1996 and completed a one-year rotating internship in 1997 and a Master's degree in 1999 at the same university. Following a few years in general practice and after having completed a residency in veterinary dermatology at the University of Montreal, he became a Diplomate of the *American College of Veterinary Dermatology* in 2004. In 2003, Dr. Sauvé joined the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vétérinaire of the Faculté de médecine vétérinaire as a clinical instructor and in 2017, he became an Assistant Professor. He has been involved in various administrative committees, as well as at the American College of Veterinary Dermatology (ACVD). In addition, Dr. Sauvé supervised senior veterinary students at the Atlantic Veterinary College (University of Prince Edward Island) for clinical rotations between 2008 and 2020 (locums). His research interests focus on feline allergy, large animal dermatology, and bacteriology. Dr. Sauvé is an active member of the Canadian Academy of Veterinary Dermatology (CAVD).
