A 1992 degree holder of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Montréal, Dr. de Jaham completed her small-animal internship at Washington State University which she followed with a dermatology residency and a Masters degree at the veterinary Faculty, University of Montreal. She obtained the diplomate status of the American College of Veterinary Dermatology in 1998. Since then, she practices referral dermatology and is actively involved in the advancement of veterinary dermatology in Canada by being the past-president of the Canadian Academy of Veterinary Dermatology since 2013. She was president between 2008-2013. She is also an affiliated clinician of dermatology at the University of Montreal.
