Dr. Sauvé is a graduate of the University of Montreal (1996) and completed a small animal internship at the same university (1997). He was in private practice in the Montreal area for three years and completed concomitantly a Masters degree at the University of Montreal in 1999, before pursuing specialization in veterinary dermatology. Dr. Sauvé completed his residency at the University of Montreal, and became a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Dermatology in 2004. Dr. Sauvé is a clinical instructor at University of Montreal since 2003. He has served as head of the Companion Animal Hospital of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (University of Montreal) from 2004 to 2007, and from 2012 to 2015. He also supervises the dermatological rotations of the senior students at the Atlantic Veterinary College (University of Prince Edward Island) from 2008 to 2013. Dr. Sauvé is an active member of the Canadian Academy of Veterinary Dermatology (CAVD).
